

KNIFE 2022. TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. KNIFE 2022. The Solingen Blade Fair is a sales show for high quality knives and blades (defined as handmade pieces, pieces from small batch series, and pieces from industrial production), for knifemaking tools and materials, and for related literature. Participants selling knives guarantee to offer only self-made pieces, or pieces from a single producer. Stands with products from more than one producer will not be accepted.

2. The host of the KNIFE is Deutsches Klingenmuseum Solingen, the German Blade Museum. The event is to be held on 14 and 15 May 2022 at the Theater und Konzerthaus Solingen.

3. Applications for participation are sent in via online form available at www.online-checkin.net/knife-2022en. Deutsches Klingenmuseum Solingen reserves the right to accept or decline any application in consultation with Deutsche Messermacher Gilde, the German Knifemakers' Guild, and Industrieverband Schneid- und Haushaltswaren, the Industry Association for Cutting Tools and Household Goods. A legal claim on participation does not exist.

4. After successful application and confirmation of participation, participants will receive an invoice for the participation fee. Payment is due within two weeks from date of invoice. Cancellation of participation is only possible until 31 December 2021. After that date, no part of the fee will be refunded. An already existing claim will remain valid.

5. Participants guarantee to uphold the regulations of the Convention on International Trade in Endangered Species of Wild Fauna and Flora (CITES) regarding the trade of materials such as (but not limited to) ivory and tortoiseshell. All goods must conform to German weapon laws (e. g., no balisongs, no OTF switchblads, no brass knuckles, no cane swords or other hidden weapons).

6. Exhibitors will have access to the exhibition rooms on both days from 08:00 onwards. The fair ends at 16:00 on Sunday, 15 May 2022. Exhibitors will have to occupy their tables until then.

7. Deutsches Klingenmuseum Solingen reserves the right to expel exhibitors from KNIFE 2022 whose commodities do not adhere to the abovementioned criteria. This does not result in any right to refunds or compensation.

8. Deutsches Klingenmuseum Solingen contracts a business public liability insurance for KNIFE. All other risks (accident, theft, etc.) will be borne by the exhibitors themselves.

9. All rooms of the event location are strictly non-smoking areas. No dogs or other pets are allowed into the building.
